Adamsville Youth Sports Code of Conduct

Youth sports programs play an important role in promoting physical, social, and emotional development of children. Therefore, it is essential for parents, coaches, spectators, and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Furthermore, parents, coaches, spectators, and officials involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control.

The Adamsville Parks and Recreation Department has developed a youth Sports Code of Conduct. The policy was approved by the Adamsville City Commission on April 23, 2024 and will be fully implemented. We ask that you pledge to be responsible for your words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in all youth sports events and shall conform your behavior to the following code of conduct while at the Adamsville City Park or representing Adamsville in another town:

- 1. Unsportsmanlike conduct by any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or other attendee will not be permitted.
- 2. Behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participate, official, or any other attendee will not be permitted.
- 3. Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products are not allowed in the Adamsville City Park.
- 4. Profanity or any other offensive language will not be tolerated.
- 5. Everyone should be treated with respect (Children, parents, coaches, umpires/referees, park employees, or other individuals).
- 6. Fighting will not be allowed.

Anyone who fails to conform their conduct to the preceding code of conduct while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in a youth sports event will be subject to disciplinary actions, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- 1. Verbal warning issued by the league or organization.
- 2. Written warning issued by the league of organization.
- 3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth sports event issued by the league or organization or by someone who is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection by the league or organization.
- 4. Suspension from multiple youth sports events by the league or organization or by appropriate official authorized to issue such suspension by the league or organization.
- 5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by the league or organization.

The City of Adamsville Parks & Recreation is committed to laying the foundation for athletic competitiveness, sportsmanship, and character development. Our mission is to be a youth program that allows children to experience, develop interest, and engage with sports in a safe and fun environment.
